

Project: Heritage Apartment Complex

Colour Rationale: This is the view facing south right on the harbour foreshore. This was the side of the building that we had to allow a colour change to compensate for the overly blue light level coming from the south plus the blue reflection from the harbour. We used heritage colours to enhance the architecture but also brought a more cohesive look to the building by enhancing the colour of the roof tiles and bringing back a more traditional colour to the shingles, therefore lifting the property value.

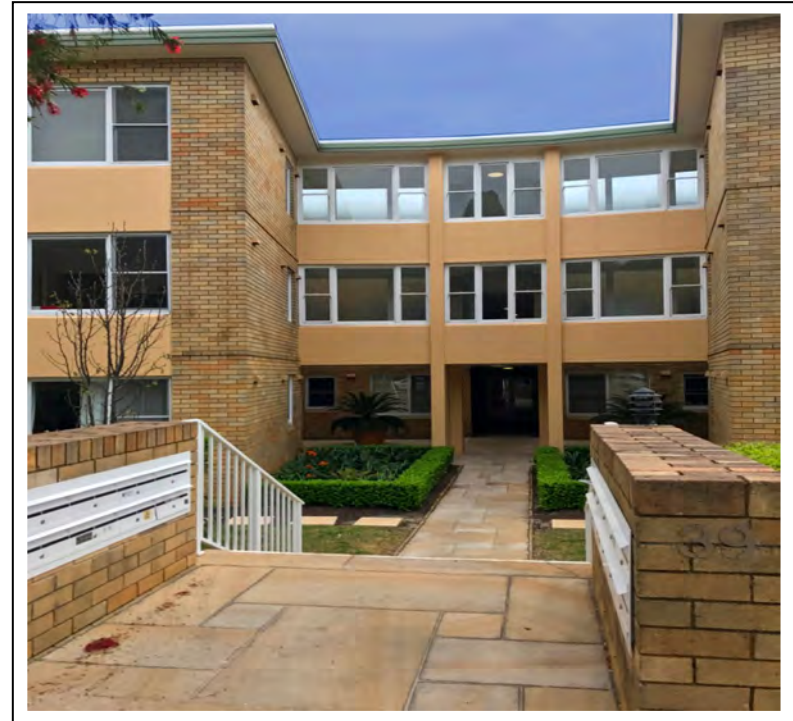

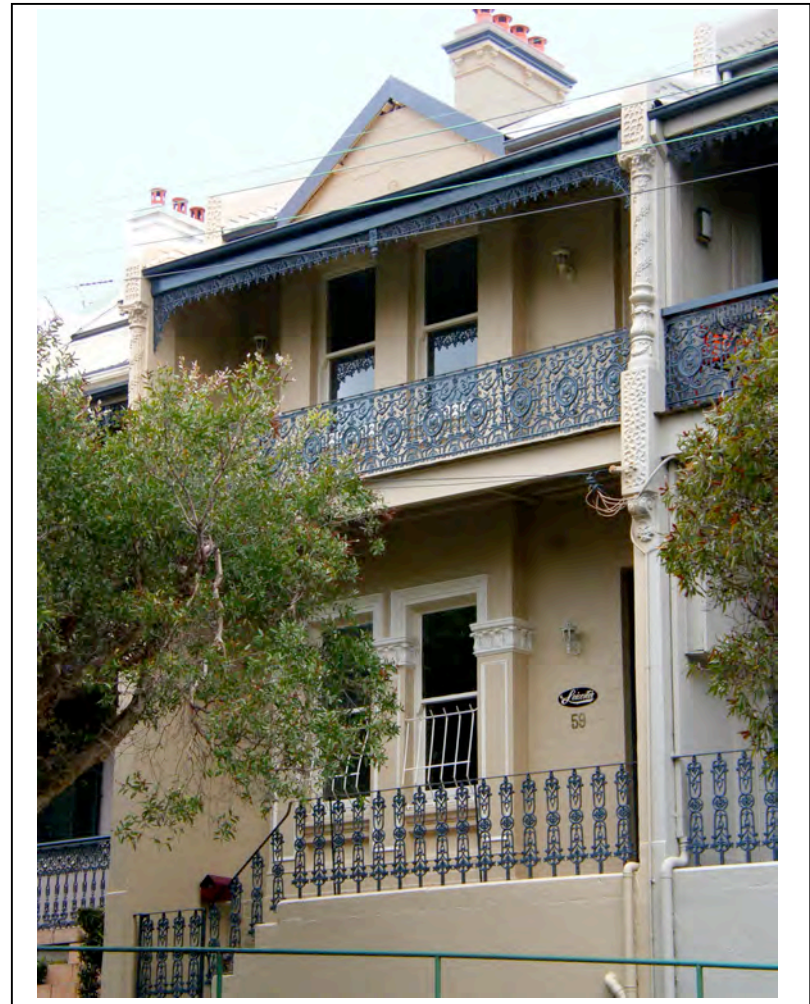
